

RESOLUTION NO. 17

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Pablo desires, in cooperation with the Council of the City of Richmond, and the Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa, to establish a uniform system covering zoning of, and permits for, buildings constructed on lots or parcels of land which are crossed by corporate limit boundary lines of the City of San Pablo, such lots or parcels of land thus lying partly within the City of San Pablo and partly within the City of Richmond, or in an unincorporated portion of the County of Contra Costa,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of San Pablo as follows:

1. Each lot or parcel of land lying partly within the City of San Pablo and partly outside the City of San Pablo shall be deemed subject to the provisions of all zoning, building, plumbing and electrical ordinances of the City of San Pablo under the following conditions:

a. If facing the lot or parcel from the street, the right half of the frontage lies within the City of San Pablo.

b. If the frontage of the lot or parcel, or more than half of the frontage of the lot or parcel lies within the City of San Pablo.

2. As used herein, the word "frontage" shall be deemed to be the boundary of the lot or parcel of land abutting the street designated in the street address of the lot or parcel. If the property has two boundaries and two streets addresses on different streets, the longer of the two boundaries shall be deemed to be the frontage
